Decisions to be made

- Do you want to use a quota or unlimited priority?
 - If you do use a quota how will you determine this? You may wish to consider the national average, city wide average or another option.
- Will you tie the priority to a specific area e.g catchment area?
- Where will you place it in your list of oversubscription criteria.

Nuances to consider

- You will need to design a supplementary form to collect evidence of pupil premium eligibility.
- You will need to decide what kind of evidence you will consider to determine eligibility.
- Which types of Premium will you give priority for Pupil Premium and or Service Premium?
- You must use the term 'eligible for' rather than 'in receipt of'.
- You must use 'Pupil Premium' rather than 'Free School Meals'.
